- ⌚ Monsters and mythical creatures (make comparisons using a brief description of each).
  - Who or what is the Cyclops in your life? Who or what do you feel gets you in trouble or threatens your well-being?
  - Who or what are the Sirens in your life? Who or what makes you want to plug your ears or tempts you?
  - Who or what is your Penelope? What gives you a sense of balance in your life? Think of someone or something that makes all the hardships worth it.
  - Who or what is your Argos? Discuss someone who has been faithful to you throughout all the hard times.
  - Who or what is the Scylla in your life? Who or what scares you?
  - Who or what is the Charybdis in your life? Name a person or thing that sucks you into their mess.
  - Who or what is your Athena? Who or what provides you with guidance?
